Mayor Roswarski to fill five positions on new Bicycle Pedestrian Advisory Committee

LAFAYETTE, INDIANA – December 12, 2017 – The City of Lafayette is currently looking for applicants for the newly forming Bicycle Pedestrian Advisory Committee. This committee will serve as a citizen's forum for discussion and recommendations that will improve the quality, safety and accessibility of our community for those who bike, run or walk.

The City is currently looking to fill five vacant slots on this committee for one year and two year terms. All citizens are encouraged to apply. However, the City is looking for at least one member from a local bicycle club, one member from a local runners club and one member from the Mayor's Youth Council. The deadline for applications will be January 2, 2018. Mayor Roswarski will choose the five candidates from the list of applicants.
